New Brunswick High School Freshmen Charged After Making Violent Threats Against the School

On December 14, 2021 detectives from the New Brunswick Police Department and Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office identified a 14 year old New Brunswick High School student who had sent a text message earlier in the day threatening violence in a New Brunswick school. The text message circulated online via social media, causing fear and concern amongst students, parents and school faculty. The student suspect who resides in New Brunswick and attends the high school has been charged with the following offenses:

Creating a False Public Alarm, 2nd degree Terroristic Threats, 3rd degree Cyber Harassment, 3rd degree.

Anyone with information regarding this incident is asked to contact Detective Jose C. Gomez at (732) 745-5222. As is the case with all criminal defendants, the charges against the juvenile suspect are merely accusations and he/she is presumed innocent until proven guilty.
