New Business

1. Review of Stormwater Advisory Committee Policy and Rules

Patrick Beane presented updates to the Stormwater Advisory Committee Policy and Rules.

2. Nominations for committee chair and vice chair

Patrick Beane reviewed the general duties of the chair and vice chair. He explained the nomination process included in the committee rules. Nominations were requested for chair. Jenni Klise and Theresa Finnegan nominated Gloria Hoffman. Gloria accepted the nomination. Nominations were requested for vice chair. Gloria Hoffman nominated Jenni Klise. Jenni accepted the nomination. Additional nominations will be received through the May 19, 2020 meeting. Voting for the chair and vice chair will also take place at that meeting.

3. City-Wide Stormwater Master Plan Update

Patrick Beane gave an update on the Stormwater Master Plan RFP. There were 6 teams that submitted proposals for the RFP. The phase 1 costs ranged from \$100,000-\$600,000.

4. Stormwater Capital Project Update



Patrick Beane gave an update on capital projects. They included Citywide stormwater, Easter Lake Watershed, Closes Creek Watershed, Leetown Creekway, Hamilton Drain, Gray's Station Detention, Crawford Creek Watershed, and the Flood Mitigation Program. An overview of the Watershed Repair Program and the Stormwater Best Management Practices Rebate Program were also given.

5. Stormwater Capital Budget Update

Patrick Beane gave an update on the capital budget. It included an overview of budget schedule, funding sources, stormwater CIP history and current 5-year plan.

6. Stormwater Infrastructure Funding Update

Patrick Beane gave an update on stormwater utility funding. It included the stormwater utility fees have been approved through 2023 and Local Option Sales and Service Tax update,

7. Stormwater Public Outreach/Education Update

Patrick Beane gave an update on the Public Works website, the Des Moines Public Information Office support, the metro wide Rain Campaign efforts, and Des Moines Waterworks billing inserts.

8. Stormwater Ordinance/Policy Update

Patrick Beane gave an update on Chapter 135 Planning and Design stormwater requirements, the upcoming sump pump discharge ordinance update, and the Capital Crossroads regional effort for all metro cities to update their stormwater design standards to the more stringent Iowa Stormwater Management Manual requirements.
