1. **Consent Calendar**

- a. Motion to approval the November 8, 2018 regular meeting minutes as amended by Vice-Chair Eichelberger. Seconded by Commissioner Bennett. Minutes approved.

2. **Unfinished Business**

- a. Hayden History Book Volume II – Commissioner Bennett met with Taryn Thompson and Kathy Rubow regarding Cramps Bay. These two individuals seem to be possibly related but do not know each other. Commissioner Bennett will be possibly facilitating a joint meeting with them. They have several additional photos and more information regarding the family and the geographical area.
