**1. CONSENT CALENDAR**

- A. Approval of February 20, 2019 meeting minutes for Parks, Recreation & Community Forestry Commission (Action Item)

**3. UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

- A. Disc Golf Course Sponsorship (Action Item)  
Vice-Chair Sampsel and Commissioner Turner met and discussed sponsorship details. The City Council recently approved this project. The commission needs to finalize the sponsor page information and get it approved by city staff. There will be five holes, \$1,000 for 5 years. City will do maintenance of signage, etc. A draft of the sponsorship sheet will be presented at the next meeting. The commission will finalize who will approach which business for possible sponsorship. Vice-Chair asked about getting feedback from the Broadmoore Park neighborhood and/or asking their Homeowner's Association what their feedback is regarding a disc golf course. The HOA meets the first week of April. Vice-Chair Sampsel and Commissioner Turner will attend the meeting and report back to the commission at the next meeting. Alan Soderling, Public Works Director, suggested they remind the homeowners that it is a community park. This item will be moved to the next meeting agenda to finalize. Commissioner Turner asked if they can get a list of merchants in the City of Hayden. Alan said that might be a possibility or even the Hayden Chamber of Commerce might have a list. Vice-Chair Sampsel will email Suzie a copy of the sponsorship draft.

**4. REPORTS**

**A. Parks Update**

Alan spoke of the playground equipment at Stoddard Park. Installation will begin when the weather allows. There has been some discussion regarding the installation of batting cages at Croffoot Baseball park. That discussion and planning will continue with Hayden Little League.

**B. Recreation & Community Events Update**

Suzie Cano introduced Adalyn Curtis, one of the newest commission members. She is a 16 year old sophomore at Coeur d'Alene High School. She feels that this will be a great experience for her. She participated in our youth recreation programs when she was younger. Welcome Adalyn! Suzie mentioned that our youth basketball season is now over. There are 15 teams in youth volleyball, 50-60 teams in soccer and the women's basketball season is currently going on now. Her department is currently taking registration for coed 4's volleyball. Arbor Day and Kite Festival are coming up and the entertainment for Hayden Days is all set.


C. Tree, Parks & Bike Pedestrian Report
