Mazie,

I hope this email finds that your Christmas break and new year were wonderful for you!!!

As we all have gotten back to the new year; I am forwarding you a copy of a certified letter that will be coming to you regarding Hurricane Irene Recovery and our invoices to the County. We are approaching the 90 day payment period for the Hurricane Irene recovery work we did for you and wanted to alert you to that fact.

In this email; I also want to encourage you (if it has not been already done) that Hyde County communicate in writing with the NC Division of Emergency Management (and its parent organization; the Department of Crime Control & Public Safety) concerning Public Assistance payments to Hyde County for Hurricane Irene recovery. I know there are some items that FEMA (and the state) have differences with Hyde County on; but for the State not to be vigorously pursuing payment on behalf of Hyde County and keeping you informed of the minute details of that pursuit is unconscionable. At this late date; for Hyde County not to have received Public Assistance reimbursement from FEMA indicates that someone who should be working on your behalf is asleep at the controls.

Some sample language in the communication could include:

"The economic hardship produced by Hurricane Irene is further compounded by FEMA and the State's lack of financial support of the County's reasonable claims. The hurricane's response and recovery costs are much more than the County can bear and the delay of help from FEMA and the State ensure that we are not able to adequately recover from the disaster. Prior to the Hurricane Irene disaster; Hyde County was operating with very limited resources and, of necessity, had been working with significantly less staff and resources than we had in past years. The hurricane and the subseque recovery work have been overwhelming. Our personnel and resources have been stretched beyond reasonable limits and we are now very dependant upon FEMA and the State providing material support on our recovery!

I urgently request that the State of North Carolina work on our behalf to obtain FEMA reimbursement of our disaster response and recovery costs. The hurricane disaster response and recovery costs have produced an ongoing crisis situation in Hyde County. I request to be kept aware of the details your efforts as we are working to balance a very difficult recovery process within the County.

I look forward to talking with you soon concerning this urgent matter."
