Sup. DeYoung moved, supported by Sup. Huff the following Ordinances:

WHEREAS the character of Missaukee County is undergoing change because of increased population pressures, and

WHEREAS, unguided haphazard growth and development can react unfavorably on the physical, social and economic well being of Missaukee County:

THEREFORE, be it ordained that Missaukee County Board of Supervisors by this ordinance, declares to proceed under the provision of Act 183 of the Public Acts of 1943 as amended, to institute study and survey toward the formation of a comprehensive development plan for the County, and provide for zoning districts within which proper use of land and natural resources may be encouraged or regulated by ordinance and to formulate such other regulations as fall within the scope of this act as will promote and sustain the general welfare of the people of Missaukee County.
