Sup. DeYoung moved, supported by Sup. Remington to adopt the Ordinance 69-1 3<sup>rd</sup>

ORDINANCE NO. 69-1 3RD AMENDMENT

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES ORDAIN:

1. There is hereby created a planning commission to be known as the Missaukee County Planning Commission, pursuant to the act 282 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan, 1945, whose office will be located at Lake City, Michigan.
2. The Missaukee County Planning Commission shall have all powers and duties as provided by law.
3. (a) The Commission shall be constituted of eight members, who shall serve for a term of three years and until their successors are appointed and qualified.  
  
(b) The Board of Commissioners shall be broadly based and representative of the interests of all areas in the planning region, including rural areas. The Commissioners shall individually be representative of important segments of economic, governmental, social life, and development of the County.  
  
(c) Two Commissioners shall be appointed for a term of one year. Three Commissioners shall be appointed for a term of two years. Three Commissioners shall be appointed for a term of three years. Thereafter, Commissioners shall be appointed for a term of three years.

(d) The Missaukee County Board of Supervisors shall fill any vacancy in the membership for any unexpired term.

4. The following officers shall be ex-officio members of the Commission for terms corresponding for the respective official tenures unless otherwise deemed by the County Board of Supervisors.
5. The County Board of Supervisors may remove any member of the Commission for non-performance of duties or misconduct upon public hearing.
6. Members of the Commission shall receive compensation not to exceed that paid to members of the Board of Supervisors, and may be reimbursed for actual, reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties. Ex-officio members of the Commission shall serve without compensation.
7. All ordinances, resolutions, and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed and each section of this declared to be independent and the findings or holding of any section or subdivision thereof to be invalid or void shall not be deemed or held to affect the validity of any other section or subdivision of this ordinance. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, publication and approval of the Governor as required by law.

Passed and adopted by the County of Missaukee, Michigan on November 10, 1969.

ALSO included in the motion the following:

That the Planning Commission is increased by three members and that all eight members are appointed to the Northwest Michigan Economic Development District council for Missaukee County, Michigan after the agreeable resignation of the present members.

Also, that Robert C. Redman and Don Molitor and a resident of the City of McBain are the new appointees.
