

# ORDINANCE NO. 70-1

STATE OF MICHIGAN  
COUNTY OF MISSAUKEE COUNTY  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

JANUARY 14, 1970

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE COUNTY OF MISSAUKEE, MICHIGAN.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES ORDAIN:

1. There is hereby created and established a planning commission to be known as the Missaukee County Planning Commission, pursuant to Act 282 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan, 1945, as amended.
2. The Missaukee County Planning Commission shall have all powers and duties which may be conferred by the County Board of Supervisors upon such planning commission as provided by Act 282, PA 1945, as amended, or by any other pertinent provisions of law.
3. a. The Planning Commission shall consist of eight (8) members to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors.  
b. The terms of the Commissioners shall be as follows: Two (2) Commissioners shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year commencing (insert specific date including time of day); Three (3) Commissioners shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years beginning (insert specific date including time of day); Three (3) Commissioners shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years beginning (insert date certain). After the termination of each of the terms as hereinabove set forth, each Commissioner shall be appointed for a term of three years and until appointment and qualification of the successor thereof.  
c. The Missaukee County Board of Supervisors shall fill by appointment any vacancy in the membership of the Planning Commission, such appointment to extend throughout the balance of the unexpired term.  
d. The basis for representative on the Commission shall be as follows: One (1) Commissioner shall be appointed from each of the following segments of the community: agriculture, recreation, education, government, transportation, industry and commerce. The eighth (8<sup>th</sup>) Commissioner shall be appointed from the community at large. No more than one (1) Commissioner shall be appointed or shall serve at the same time from any of the above designated segments of the community.
4. Each of the following officers shall serve as ex officio member of the Commission during his/her official tenure in each of the following offices:
  - a. County Extension Director
  - b. County Sanitarian
  - c. Chairman, Agricultural Committee of Missaukee County Board of Supervisors
5. The County Board of Supervisors may by majority vote remove any member of the Commission for nonperformance of duties or misconduct after public hearing upon written notice of at least two weeks.
6. Members of the Commission may be reimbursed for actual, reasonable and necessary expense incurred in the discharge of their duties after approval of such expenses by the Board of Supervisors but shall receive no other compensation.
7. Any and all acts done, performed, or authorized by the Missaukee County Planning Commission as originally established by the Board of County Supervisors of Missaukee County as of January 2, 1962, as amended by Ordinance 69-1, 3<sup>rd</sup> Amendment, adopted June 9, 1969, and/or as further amended by Ordinance 69-1, 3<sup>rd</sup> Amendment, adopted November 10, 1969, is hereby approved, confirmed, ratified and adopted. This

Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, publication and approval of the Governor, as required by law.
