

**ORDINANCE # 95-1
AMENDMENT TO THE MISSAUKEE COUNTY
STREET AND ROAD NUMBERING ORDINANCE**

PREAMBLE

An ordinance to amend Section 8 of the Missaukee County Street and Road Numbering Ordinance by providing for a civil infraction penalty.

Whereas, on July 13, 1993, the Board of Commissioners adopted a street and road numbering ordinance;

Whereas, that ordinance carries a criminal penalty;

Whereas, the Michigan legislature has now authorized municipal civil infractions as a penalty for county ordinances;

Whereas, the county wants the penalty for a violation of this ordinance to be a civil violation;

Whereas, the Missaukee County Sheriff Department shall be the ordinance with powers that include but are not limited to issuing and serving citations;

IT IS HEREBY determined and declared to be necessary and in the public interest to amend Section 8 of the Missaukee County Street and Road Numbering Ordinance to provide for a penalty of a civil infraction for violations of the ordinance and to establish the Missaukee County Sheriff Department as the authorized local officials to carry out the enforcement of this ordinance.

**Ordains Section 8 of the Street and Road Numbering
Ordinance be amended as follows:**

SECTION 8: ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY

A. Any person, firm, partnership or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be responsible for a Municipal Civil Infraction as defined by Michigan law and subject to a civil fine determined in accordance with the following schedule:

	<u>Fine</u>
1 st Violation-----	\$25.00
2 nd Violation-----	\$50.00
3 rd Violation-----	\$75.00

B. In addition to the fine, the court may assess court costs which cost shall not be more than \$25.00.

C. The Missaukee County Sheriff Department shall be the ordinance enforcement officers for this ordinance and the sheriff, undersheriff and deputies shall have all of the powers enumerated for the Authorized local official under P.A. 12 of 1994 (MCLA 600.8701 et seq.) including but not limited to issuing and serving citations.

D. In addition to the imposition of the foregoing fines and costs, the Sheriff Department may cause the proper posting of numbers, and the cost thereof shall be assessed against the owner of the premises.

E. Any part of a calendar month in which a violation exists shall constitute a separate offense.

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days following the publication thereof as required by law.

PREAMBLE

IT IS HEREBY determined and declared to be necessary and in the public interest to amend Section 8 of the Missaukee County Street and Road Numbering Ordinance to provide for a penalty of a civil infraction for violations of the ordinance and to establish the Missaukee County Sheriff Department as the authorized local officials to carry out the enforcement of this ordinance.

**SECTION 8: ENFORCE-
MENT AND PENALTY**

A. Any person, firm, partnership or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be responsible for a Municipal

Civil Infraction as defined by Michigan law and subject to a civil fine determined in accordance with the following schedule:

	Fine
1st Violation.....	\$25.00
2nd Violation.....	\$50.00
3rd and Subsequent Violation	\$75.00

B. In addition to the fine, the court may assess court costs which cost shall not be more than \$25.00.

C. The Missaukee County Sheriff Department shall be the ordinance enforcement officers for this ordinance and the sheriff, undersheriff and deputies shall have all of the powers enumerated for the "authorized local official" under P.A. 12 of 1994 (MCLA 600.8701 et seq.) including but not limited to issuing and serving citations.

D. In addition to the imposition of the foregoing fines and costs, the Sheriff's Department may cause the proper posting of numbers, and the cost thereof shall be assessed against the owner of the premises.

E. Any part of a calendar month in which a violation exists shall constitute a separate offense.

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days following the publication thereof as required by law.
