An ordinance to designate a violation described in subsection (1) and (2) of section 23 of the state construction code act as a municipal civil infraction and to provide a civil fine for the violation in accordance with the provisions of the state construction code act (act no. 230 of the public acts of 1972, as amended)

THE COUNTY OF MISSAUKEE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Administration and Enforcement.

The County of Missaukee continues to assume responsibility for the administration and enforcement of the State Construction Code (Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended).

Section 2. Municipal Civil Infraction.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan State Construction Code, in accordance with Section 23 of Act 230, P.A. 1972, as amended, the County of Missaukee hereby designates a violation described in subsection (1) or (2) of Section 23 of the act as a municipal civil infraction.

Section 3. Civil fine.

The civil fine for a violation of subsection (1) or (2) of Section 23 of the Michigan State Construction Code Act is a fine up to and not more than \$500.00.

Section 4. Repeals.

All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Publication.

This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing same.

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE A VIOLATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) AND (2) OF SECTION 23 OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION

CODE ACT AS A MUNICIPAL CIVIL INFRACTION AND TO PROVIDE A CIVIL FINE FOR THE VIOLATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT (ACT NO. 230 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED)

THE COUNTY OF MISSAUKEE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT.

The County of Missaukee continues to assume responsibility for the administration and enforcement of the State Construction Code (Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended).

SECTION 2. MUNICIPAL CIVIL INFRACTION.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan State Construction Code, in accordance with Section 23 of Act 230, P.A. 1972, as amended, the County of Missaukee hereby designates a violation described in subsection (1) or (2) of Section 23 of the act as a municipal civil infraction.

SECTION 3. CIVIL FINE.

The Civil fine for a violation of subsection (1) or (2) of Section 23 of the Michigan State Construction Code Act is a fine up to and not more than \$500.00.

SECTION 4. REPEALS.

All ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
