AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE AN ENFORCING AGENCY TO DISCHARGE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COUNTY OF MISSAUKEE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT (ACT NO. 230 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED.)

The County of Missaukee ordains:

Section 1. Agency Designated.

Pursuant to the provision of the Michigan State Construction Code, in accordance with Section 9 of Act 230, P.A. 1972, as amended, the Building Official of the County of Missaukee is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the County of Missaukee under Act 230, P.A. 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The County of Missaukee assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout its corporate limits.

Section 2. Repeals.

All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Publication.

This Ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing same.
