PUBLIC NUISANCE ORDINANCE

An ordinance to secure the public health, safety, and general welfare of the residents and property owners of the Aetna Township, Missaukee County, Michigan, by the regulation of public nuisances within said township; to prescribe the penalties for the violation thereof.

The Township of Atena, Missaukee County, Michigan ordains:

SECTION 1: TITLE

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Township Public Nuisance Ordinance."

SECTION 2: REGULATIONS

A. GENERAL REGULATIONS. No person, firm or corporation shall cause or create any unreasonable or unnecessary disturbance, injuries to the health, peace, or quiet of the residents and property owners of the township.

B. SPECIFIC VIOLATIONS. The following disturbances are hereby declared to be a violation of this ordinance, provided,

shall unreasonably disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of any person in the vicinity; such as allowing or permitting any dog to bark repeatedly in an area where such barking can be clearly heard from nearby residential property.

SECTION 3: PENALTIES

Any person, firm or corporation found violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed 90 days, or both by such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation shall continue is to constitute a separate offense. Provisions of this ordinance may also be enforced by suit for injunction, damages or other appropriate legal action.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This notice shall become in effect 30 days from first publication.
