

# COVID-19 Donations

Steele County Public Health is asking that individuals who are interested in donating personal protective equipment (PPE) or monetary donations in response to the COVID-19 pandemic should contact Steele County Public Health. Donations will be utilized for Steele County COVID-19 response. PPE donations will be properly vetted and distributed to Steele County Healthcare Providers and Public Safety partners per the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Minnesota Department of Health's recommendations.

Examples of acceptable equipment donations are as follows:

- N95 Masks
- Surgical Masks
- Homemade Cloth Masks
- Disposable Gowns
- Reusable Gowns
- Eye Protection (i.e. face shields and goggles that fully cover the front and sides of the face)
- Non-sterile Gloves
- Hand Sanitizer
