Samaritan Inn chief named

A pastor and experienced fundraiser, Rick Crocker, took over the reins of the Samaritan Inn homeless program this week.

Crocker replaces Executive Director Lynne Sipiora, who is retiring after spending the last 10 years with the program in McKinney.

The new executive brings extensive experience to the position. He served as Executive Director of The Erie City Mission in Erie, Pennsylvania for the last five years, leading a staff of 67 employees, while overseeing a \$3.5 million budget. He served as Senior Pastor of the First Alliance Church in Erie from 1989 to 2009.

His extensive experience in organizational leadership, fundraising and development will serve the Inn well as a new state-of-the-art family shelter is built to meet the ever-increasing needs of homeless families in our community. The Samaritan Inn broke ground on the new shelter on June 22.

The Samaritan Inn is a comprehensive homeless program that helps willing people gain dignity and independence. On a typical night, 160 residents live at The Samaritan Inn. Consistently, thirty percent of residents are children. The Inn is currently undergoing a \$6.5 million dollar Capital Campaign.

After the American Civil War, more than 100 American heiresses crossed the Atlantic to find hus-

bands among the English nobility, taking their fortunes with them. As in "Downton Abbey," these partnerships often saved palaces and castles, introducing modern facilities and turning these country houses into magnificent repositories of paintings, sculpture and decorative

arts. Mackey's program will spotlight three such American heiresses, whose stories are ones of riches and intrigue but also poignant insight into the social changes that transformed British society in the 20th century.
